Privacy Policy

This website (the “Site”) – which is managed by Fonkoze USA – is a safe environment for anyone who visits or makes a donation. The Fonkoze Family values your support and is committed to protecting your privacy.

The purpose of this statement is to share with you our policy concerning your privacy.

What information do we collect and how do we use it?

Fonkoze USA does not ask for personal information to access most of the Site. You can browse our Site without telling us who you are or revealing any personal information about yourself. However, you must enter identifying information to access certain features. The information you provide to Fonkoze USA is stored in a secure location.

Currently, Fonkoze USA requires personal information on the following pages of the Site:

Mailing list signup: Information you provide to sign up for our general mailing list will be used for communications from Fonkoze USA, including e-newsletters. Fonkoze USA reserves the right to share this information with other entities.

Contact page: Contact information you send us via the feedback page is used only to reply to your request, and is not stored in our database, unless you have requested otherwise.

Analytics: When you visit our Site, we collect some non-identifying basic information. This includes total number of visitors, pages viewed, and other non-identifying information. We use this aggregate information to improve our Site and to make your experience on our website as smooth as possible.

Donations: Donations made on-line to us are secure. When you make a donation on-line, we ask for your name, address, daytime phone, e-mail address, and credit card information. We use your information to process your donation(s) and to verify credit

card data. We use your mailing address to send your tax-deductible receipt(s) and to keep you informed about what we are doing in Haiti and the U.S. We do not use for mailing purposes or correspondence any of the honoree email addresses you submit to send honor cards.

Fonkoze USA maintains a written policy to discontinue contacting any person upon that person's oral or written request directed to Fonkoze USA, its fundraiser or other agents. Do we share your information?

We reserve the right to sell, trade, or rent your personal information to anyone. We reserve the right to change our policy at any time. If we choose to change our policy, you will be given the option to remove your name from our database. To opt out, please contact us at the address provided at the end of this policy.

We may disclose personal information to respond to legal requirements, enforce our policies, or protect anyone's rights, property, or safety. Such information will be disclosed in accordance with applicable laws and regulations.

We may also share your personal information with:

- ❑ Corporate members of the Fonkoze family, including Fonkoze and Fonkoze Financial Services.
- ❑ Service providers under contract who help with our business operations.
- ❑ Law enforcement or other governmental officials, in response to a verified request relating to a criminal investigation or alleged illegal activity. In such events, we will disclose information relevant to the investigation, such as name, city, state, zip code, telephone number, and email address.
